Rescuing Food and Souls

Through the ministry of the Food Rescue Team we desire to fulfill the greater purpose of SHBC of moving students and volunteers to extraordinary life in Christ.

Purpose

The Food Rescue Team's purpose is to be a support to the many ministries of SHBC. These being - Jr. High Drop In, Youth, Community Dinner, Breakfast Club, Mom's Morning Out, Out of School Care, Needy Families of SHBC and the Mosaic Centre.

Responsibilities

Seven days a week a volunteer goes to Save On Foods at 9 am to collect donated food from the Bakery Department. This consists of 4-6 boxes of Bread, Buns, Sweets, Pies and miscellaneous bakery items. This `shrink` is then brought to SHBC for sorting, and either left at the church or taken to the Mosaic Centre. A specific schedule is provided for each day. *Time commitment* – 1-2 hours a week. Volunteers are asked to choose 1 day they can consistently pick up every week.



Throughout the course of a year the needs of each ministry using "shrink" may vary. The Food Rescue Coordinator will communicate with the team on any changes, in an effort to keep this ministry running smoothly and efficiently.

Expectations & Qualifications

Food Rescue Team members are representatives of SHBC and are expected to conduct themselves in a way that brings honour to Christ in all dealings with the people you encounter while involved in this ministry.

- A valid drivers licence and vehicle
- A heart for people and a desire to grow in your spiritual walk through participation and involvement in helping others
- Support of your involvement by immediate family
