# Faith Journey Events Schedule 2017-2018

We believe home is the primary place where faith is nurtured and lived out. To support this we offer "Faith Journey Events". One Sunday morning per year parents will have the opportunity to be with each of their children individually in a hands-on workshop to learn a new faith skill that they can continue developing at home.

## Sep 24 - Kindergarten

**My Bible:** To empower families to spend time together reading the Bible and memorizing Scripture, truly putting God's Word at the center of their lives. Each child receives their own Bible!

## Oct 15 - Grade 1

**My Church:** Allowing families to have a memorable experience together at church as they learn how much they matter to the faith community.

## Oct 29 - Grade 2

**Serving as a Family:** To inspire and engage the family in being the hands and feet of Christ through church, community and global service as a family.

## Nov 19 - Grade 3

**Family Prayer:** To empower families to develop the regular habit of prayer and thus connect the next generation to God in a powerful way.

## Dec 3 - Grade 4

**Money & Me:** To learn what Jesus has to say about money, be challenged to consider how God might shape their finances and be empowered to develop some God-honoring & freedom building money management skills at home. Helpful hints for saving, spending, giving, investing and more.

## Jan 14 - Grade 5

**Baptism & Communion:** An in depth look at these important sacraments and where they originate.

## Jan 28 - Grade 6

**Faith & Media:** How do we apply our beliefs to the media that daily engages us? Does our Christian faith make a difference in what we watch, hear or do? A serious look at TV, movies and music and how they affect our lives.

## Feb 11 - Grade 7

**Safety Online:** To empower parents and give them the information & tools that will help them effectively support and guide their children into good, safe, Christ-honoring decisions on the computer as they spend time online.

## Mar 11 - Grade 8

**Dating, Kissing, Sex and Stuff:** To challenge teenagers on their level, to think through their sexual choices from a Christian world view and to bridge the gap between teens and parents, bringing them into discussion together.

## Mar 25 - Grade 9

**My Parents are Driving Me Crazy!** The teen years can be tumultuous times for parents and students. This workshop focuses on how to have healthy communication in these challenging times.

## Apr 8 - Grade 10

**Faith Mentoring:** To help teenagers identify and establish an adult faith mentor they can turn to for advice and support and to build a stronger relationship between the youth and adults of our church family.

## Apr 29 - Grade 11

**Who Am I and What Am I Going to Do With My Life?** A spiritual gift workshop where we discover our gifts together and how these gifts help us discern where God is leading us.

## May 13 - Grade 12

**Standing Up for My Faith:** Teenagers learn the basics about cults and religions and how to stand up for their faith in challenging situations.
