Life Group Leader

We are created in the image of God, who is the perfect embodiment of community. Thus we are closer to God and our original design when we live in community.

The Primary roles of a life group leader are:

1. To conduct regular group meetings
2. To assist group members with pastoral care
3. To organize and participate in service/ministry projects with your life group
4. To join with other life group leaders to pursue leadership development

Life group leaders:

1. Serve group members
 - Weekly/biweekly group meetings
 - Service/ministry projects in church and community
2. In partnership with other leaders:
 - Accountability partners
 - All-leader ministry events
3. With the support of a coach:
 - Training sessions
 - One-on-one meeting(s) with group coach

Responsibilities:

1. Prepare and conduct meaningful group meetings
2. Meet one on one with Community Life Pastor at least two times during the year
3. Identify and mentor an apprentice leader
4. Pray for group members regularly



5. Attend group leader ministry events
6. Attend training sessions at least once a year
7. With input from the Community Life Pastor, develop a multiplication plan for group
8. Pursue leadership development with other leaders and independently
9. Co-ordinate a service project with your group

Qualities:

1. A Group Leader should:
 - Be a Christ follower who shows evidence of a Spirit-filled life
 - Hold on to no area of willful sin
 - Have good communication/people skills
 - Display leadership gifts
 - Be an active disciple maker

Approximate Time Commitment:

Group leaders commit to serve in this capacity until June of the following year. From September to June, leaders will spend approximately 10 to 15 hours per month on training, preparation and leadership.
