24-Sept	Kindergarten	My Bible: Families will be empowered to spend time together reading the Bible and memorizing Scripture, truly putting God's Word at the center of their lives. Each child receives their own Bible!
22-Oct	Grade 10-12	Faith Mentoring This workshop will give you tools to create a spiritual dialogue and help you in your walk with Christ. Parents & students will learn how to pray together, create accountability, set spiritual goals, and grow toward spiritual maturity. Students will learn how to find an adult mentor to help them in their spiritual growth.
12-Nov	Grade 1	My Church: Families will have a memorable experience together as they learn about the church and what happens in the church building. There will be a tour of our church building and each family receives a special book!
26-Nov	Grade 2	Serving as a Family: Families will be engaged in learning how to be the hands and feet of Christ through church, community, and global service as a family. Each family gets to do hands-on service projects!
21-Jan	Grade 3	Family Prayer: Families will be empowered to develop the regular habit of prayer and thus connect the next generation to God in a powerful way. Each family receives a special book!
11-Feb	Grade 4	Money & Me: Families will learn what the Bible has to say about money, be challenged to consider how God might shape their finances and be empowered to develop some God-honoring & freedom-building money management skills at home. Helpful hints for saving, spending, giving, investing and more. Each family receives a special book!
25-Feb	Grade 5	Starting Point: Families will learn what it means to start the journey of faith as a follower of Jesus. They will be provided with tools that parents can use to follow up with their children at home and that all can use to share the faith with others.
17-Mar	Grade 6	Baptism & Communion: Families will take an in-depth look at these important sacraments and where they originate. Each family receives a special book!
14-Apr	Grade 7	Safety Online: Families will be empowered and given information & tools that will help them effectively support and guide their children into good, safe, Christ-honoring decisions on the computer as they spend time online. Each family receives a special book!
28-Apr	Grade 8	Dating, Kissing, Sex and Stuff: Teenagers will be challenged on their level to think through their sexual choices from a Christian world view and to the gap between teens and parents will be bridged through bringing them together in discussion.
19- May	Grade 9	My Parents are Driving Me Crazy!: Teenagers and their parents will focus on how to have healthy communication during these challenging years of change. Each family receives a special book!
